- Nine furnished transitional housing units for single women and single mothers with minor children ages 0-12
- No adult men are allowed on the property
- Unit size varies, but all include kitchen and bathroom
- Applicants must have steady income
- Monthly program fees range from \$325 - \$425 depending on the unit
- Residents are required to participate in case management
- Sober environment

- Private rooms for women experiencing homelessness that are pregnant for the first time, who have just given birth, or who are pregnant and have a child age 2 or younger
- Free
- Program runs up to 12 months with mandatory case management and adherence to program rules
- Applicants cannot have a violent criminal history

YWCA MADISON

- Furnished, one or two bedroom units for single mothers with one or two children ages 0-4, or expectant mothers in their third trimester
- Applicants must have steady income and meet low/moderate-income eligibility
- Monthly rent ranges from \$425 - \$500 depending on the unit
- Applicants must be able to make a six-month commitment
- Residents must follow program rules

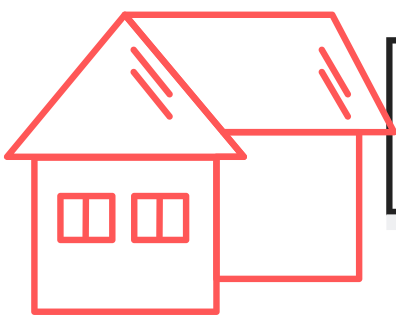
