

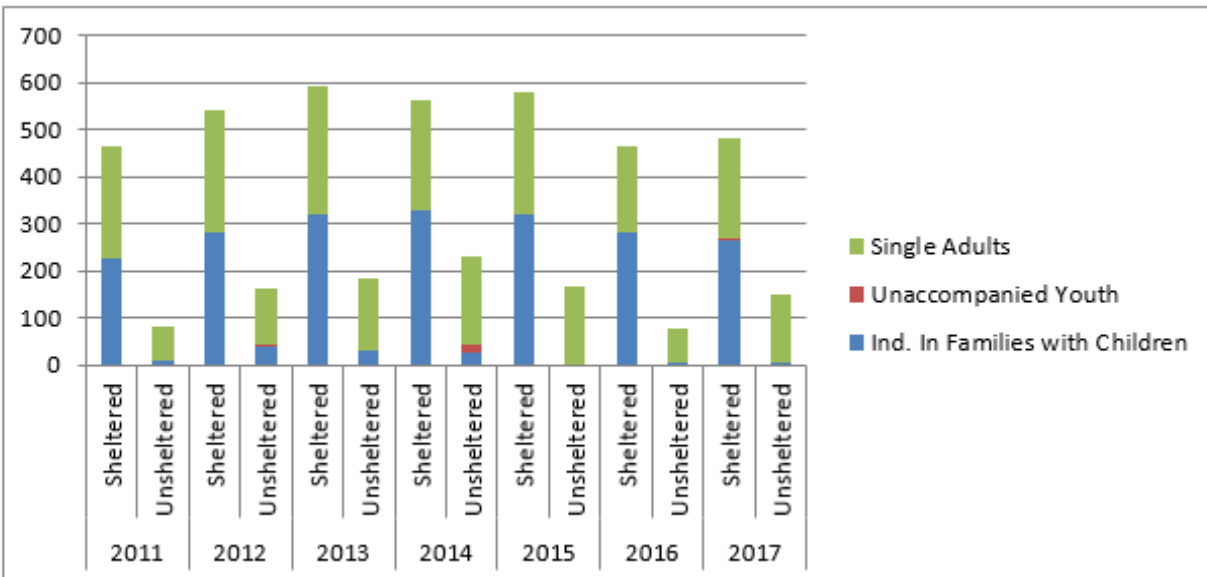

*There were 142 persons in the jail on the night of the PIT count who might have been homeless but did not get counted in the PIT: 77 persons reported no permanent address (NPA), 15 gave the Job Center or shelter addresses, and 50 reported no address at all. HUD does not include persons in institutions in the PIT count.

† In 2017, the HSC PIT Committee decided to break down the age 25+ group into two age groups for the unsheltered count: age 25-54 and age 55+. Out of 119 persons unsheltered in the age 25+ group, 84 persons were in the age 25-54 range, and 35 persons were in the age over 55 range.
